

Summerfruit ordering guidelines

Product

- Fruit type (peach, nectarine, apricot, plum)
- Flesh type (white, yellow, black, red)

Timing and variety

The Summerfruit season begins in November and ends in April. To extend the season many varieties are grown in succession, with each variety available for approximately one month.

Airfreight and seafreight configurations

- AKE-Airfreight - 130 cartons
- PMC - Airfreight - 400 cartons
- 20' Container - 8.6 tonnes - 864 cartons
- 40' Container 20 tonnes - 2028 cartons

Quantity and packaging

- 4 kg - Single layer tray (by count)
- 10 kg bulk fill carton (by weight)
